

Resources

When you find a resource you are interested in, you can click ‘view resource’ and it will provide you a link to download, as well as the name of the organization that submitted the resource. The organization will be hyperlinked so you can view their description, website, and more.

2. Open the resource.
3. Learn more about the organization that provided the resource.
4. ‘Favorite’ a resource and it will save to your user profile for easy reference.
5. Add a resource to a group you are a part of for everyone to view and use.
6. Post a comment in the discussion thread to let others know if the resource was helpful, how you used it, or how you adapted/modified it for your community.

Endorsements

By clicking the 'thumbs up' you can endorse a resource (1), or an organization (2). Once you endorse, you will get a 'thank you' notification on the screen and your endorsement will be added to current number in the 'thumbs up' icon.

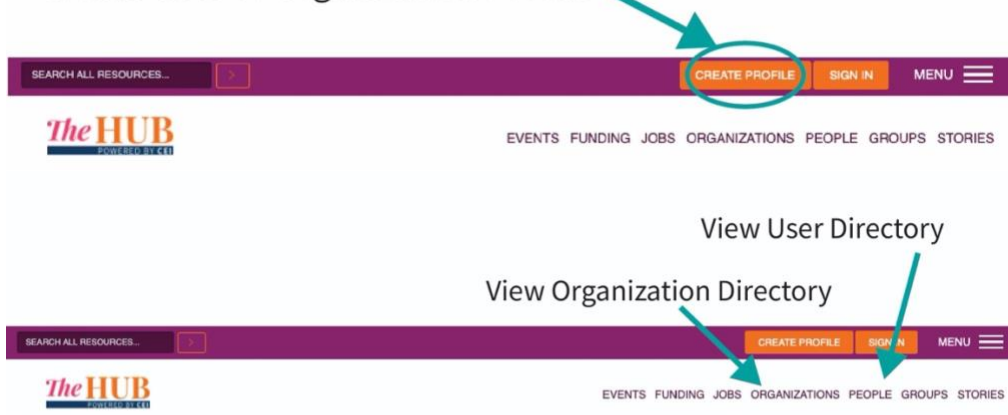

Profiles

- **Individual User Profiles** are linked to the individuals who use The Hub. When a person creates their user profile, they provide demographic information, a bio, a profile photo, and their areas of interest. A user profile is required to access some of the features on The Hub. User profiles are not linked to organization profiles.
- **Organization Profiles** are for companies, agencies, etc. to post information about their work and how to reach them. You will need to have an organization profile created to submit resources on behalf of your organization.

To create a user or organization profile, click the orange button that says, 'create profile'. A page will open that allows you enter your user profile information, and select the option to create an organization profile.

Create a Profile

User and organization profiles function independently of each other. You can have both a user profile and an organization profile.

User Profiles

- User profiles are linked to the individuals who use The Hub. When a person creates their user profile, they provide demographic information, a bio, a profile photo, and their areas of interest. A user profile is required to access some of the features on The Hub.
- Once a profile is created, the user sees a personalized dashboard when they log into The Hub.
- Users can add personal resources to their profiles, and these resources can be shared to groups. These resources are not listed in the index of organization resources, but do appear in search results.
- Hub log-in is required to upload personal resources – the resource upload link is on the user dashboard.
- Hub users can edit their individual profiles when signed into The Hub.

Organization Profiles

- Organization profiles are for companies, agencies, etc. to post information about their work and how to reach them.
- Organization profiles are displayed on a single web page with an image or logo, description text, a link to the organization's website, and a list of the content the organization has published on The Hub.
- Organization resources appear in The Hub's content index. Organization resources can be shared to groups.
- Hub log-in is not required to submit organization resources, but you will need to have an organization profile created to complete the submission process.
- Hub users do not have access to edit organization profiles; these changes need to be sent to Hub Manager Susan Paulsen.

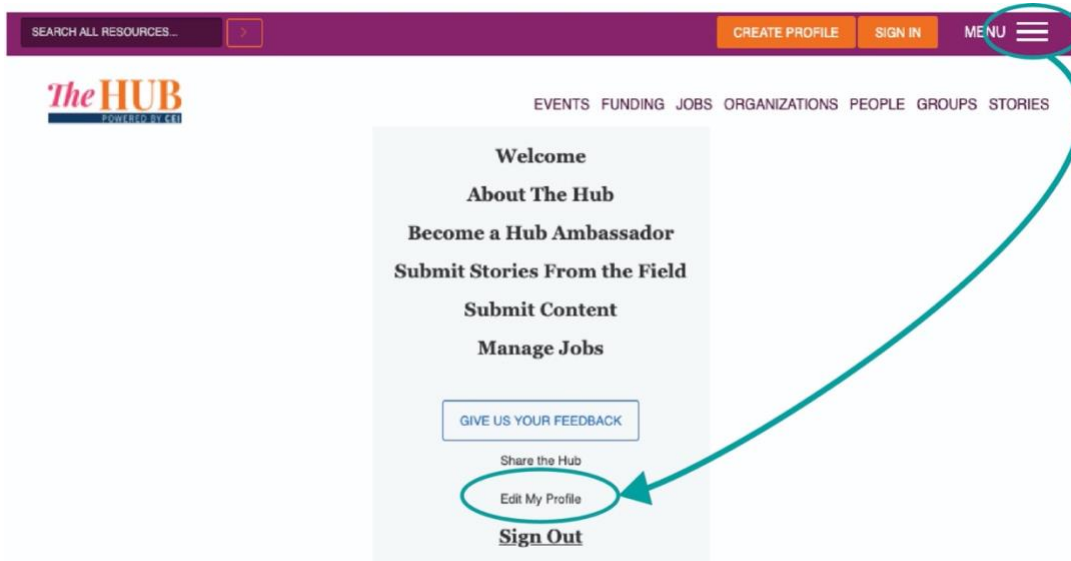

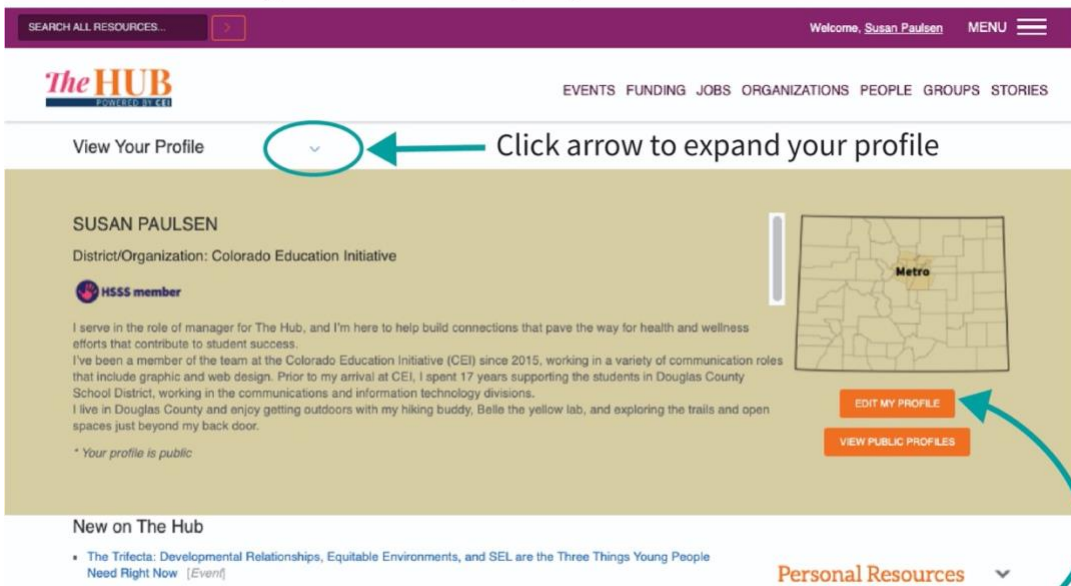

Groups

Groups can be created in 2 ways.
